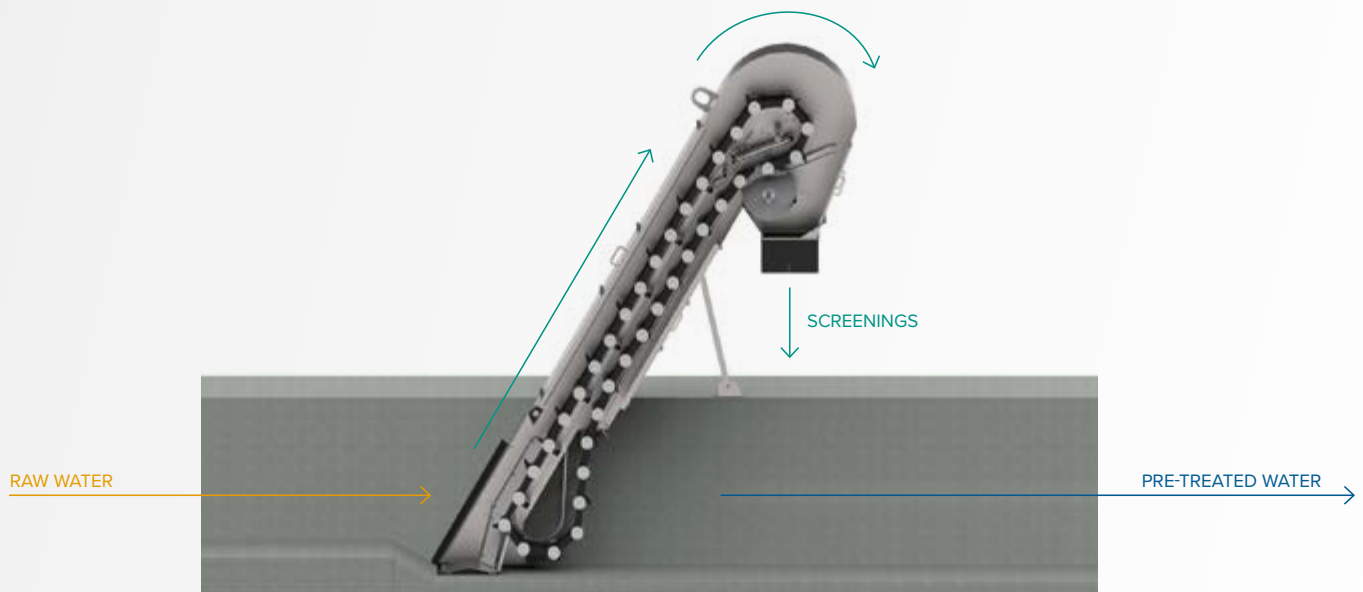

Design and properties of the Belt Screen

- The endless belt is tailor-made to the type of application
- Automatic and adjustable spraying ensures perfect cleaning of the endless belt and rinsing of the screenings
- A belt screen cover to eliminate odours and increase the hygiene standard of the WWTP is always included with the device
- Sophisticated sealing of the space between the endless belt and the bottom of the channel
- A reliable system monitors the tension of the endless belt, preventing overloading and device damage

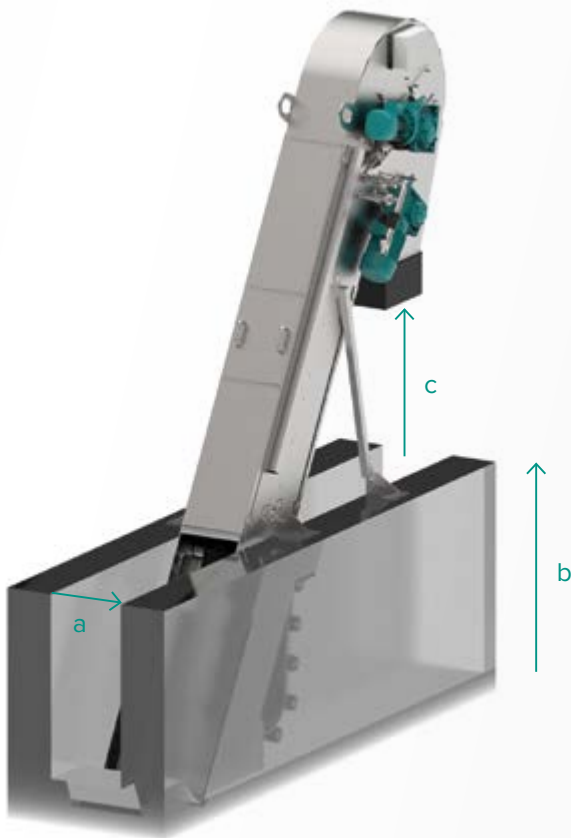
How does it work?

Untreated water flows by gravity towards the screen belt, which traps solids from the water larger than the installed openings. These screenings are subsequently carried above the water

surface to the head of the belt screen, where they fall into a hopper. The screen bars are cleaned by a rotating brush and optionally rinsed. The belt screen cleaning is initiated together with the belt

drive. Belt operation can be controlled by a timer or the water-level probe supplied as standard.

The screen discharge hopper is usually connected to a screw conveyor or a screw press.

Design

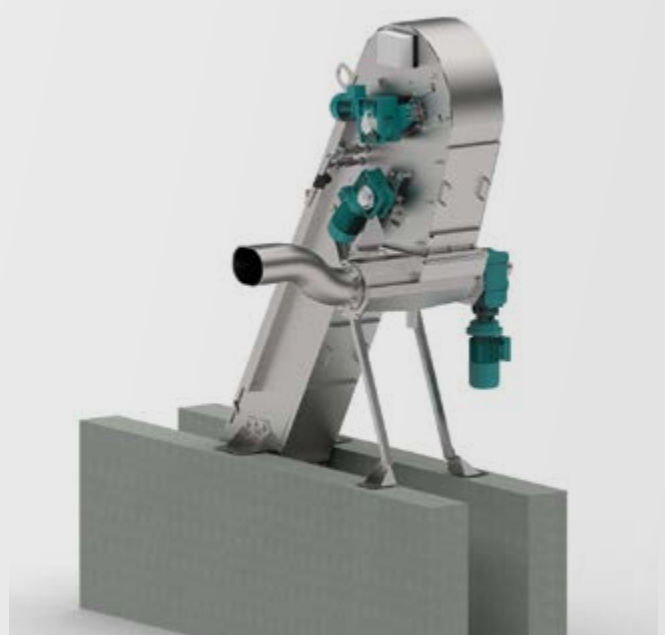
The belt screens are divided into coarse (10–100 mm) and fine (1–10 mm) according to the size of the openings in each screen. Depending on the belt screen space and capacity, we choose a 60° or 75° inclination or a completely customized inclination.

Optimal belt screen operation can be managed using a PLC or other computerized system.

The belt screen can be delivered for a concrete channel installation or in a steel tank depending on the specific situation.

For outdoor installations, we offer an insulated version with optional heating and waterproofing for the electrical components.
